## What is a Campus Master Plan?

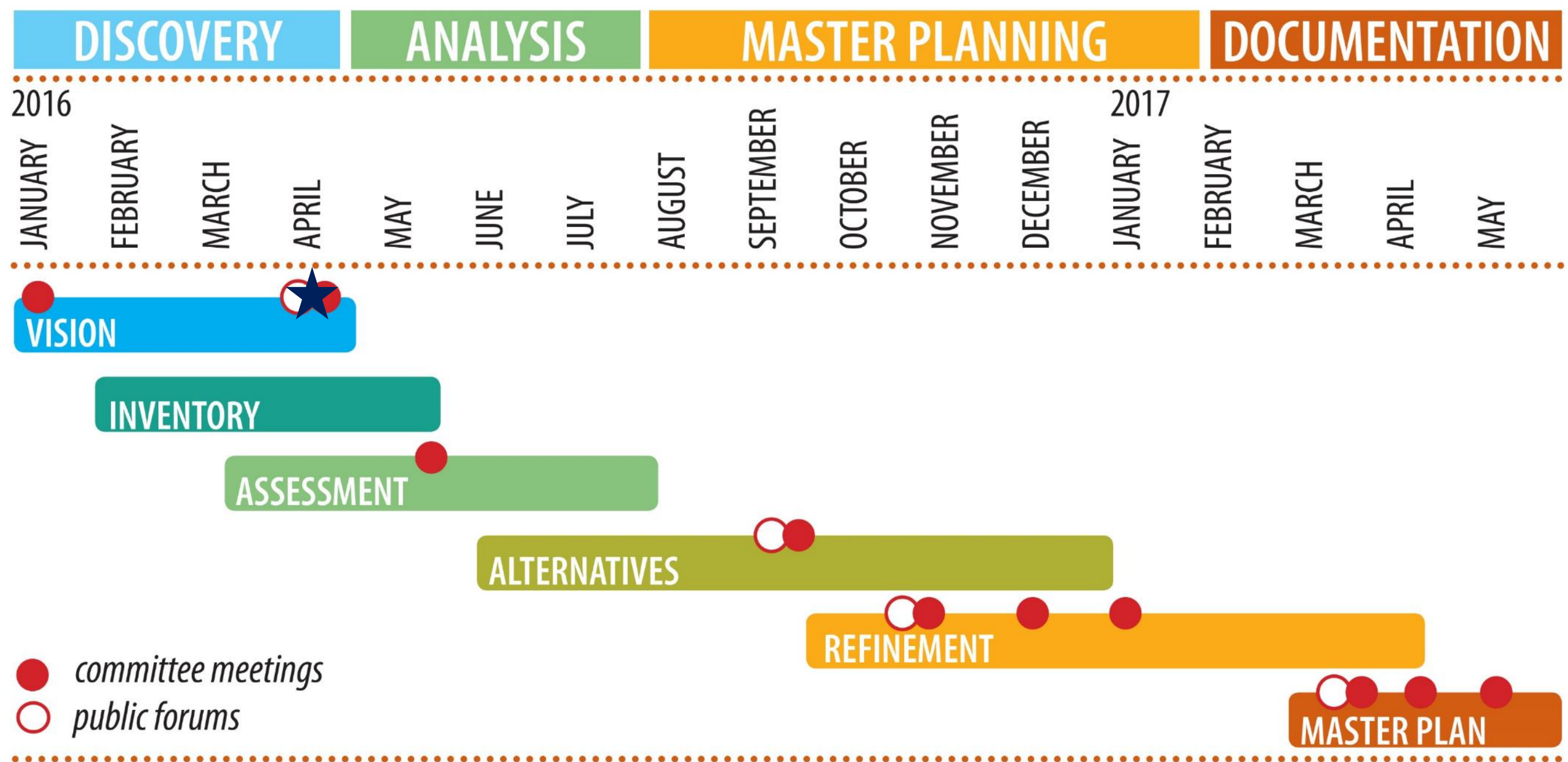
